

THE PANTHER PAW PROGRAM

The Panther Paw Program is an awards program designed to recognize students for services rendered to Pine View High School. Panther Paw Pins are awarded at the Panther Paw Assembly on May 15, 2008.

FILLING OUT THE BOOKLET

1. First, find the activity you participated in.
2. Then, in the appropriate box next to the activity (10th grade, 11th grade or 12th grade) you **must** include the following:
 - a. The signature of the advisor, teacher, or supervisor of the activity. You can't receive points without this signature, and the advisor has final word on whether or not you should receive the points.
 - b. Where there is more than one possibility in the category (for example, in the case of clubs or athletics), the name of the activity written as clearly as possible.
 - c. The **total** number of points you believe you earned in that category. This is especially important when you participated in more than one activity in a category (for example, wrestling and football in athletics)
3. Finally, under the "Explanations or Comments" section at the end of the book, write the total number of points and the paw you believe you earned.

Other rules and instructions:

1. Fill out the GPA/ACT section but do not have it signed. The Panther Paw Committee will check your points after the book is turned in. Please attach a transcript.
 2. Make your entries as clear as possible to ensure that you receive all the points to which you're entitled.
 3. The decision of the Panther Paw Committee is final and binding.
 4. If you are unsure about an entry, attach a note or speak to Mrs. Richardson (room 119).
 5. A Panther Paw Assembly will be held at the end of the year to recognize recipients.
- Attendance is mandatory** at the assembly in order to receive your award unless school excused or cleared through Mrs. Richardson.
6. Points are cumulative. That means if you didn't earn a paw in your sophomore year because you only had 35 points, you begin your junior year with those 35 points.
 7. You can only win one paw per year.
 8. If you have not completed an activity by the time the booklets are due, they can be counted with next year's points unless you're a senior. If you are a senior, include a note explaining the spring activities you're involved in, **and** contact Mrs. Richardson when you have actually earned those points so that they can be added to your total.

Finally, turn your completed book into Mrs. Richardson in room 119 by Tuesday, April 29th. Late books will not be accepted.
