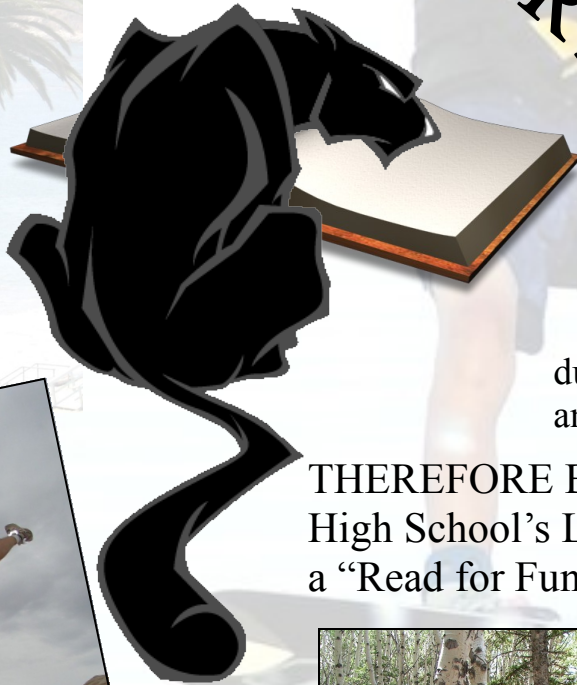

PANTHERS READ FOR FUN

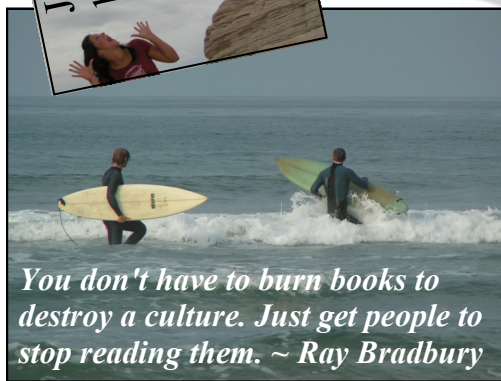


WHEREAS: Reading is the key to success in all areas of school and life.
