Washington County School District 3700 Technology Acceptable Use Policy

1. Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure appropriate, responsible, ethical and legal access and use of computers, the Internet, and other electronic or communication devices by District students, patrons, and employees. . . .

Student Internet Login Authentication

Apologies to those who already know this...



Your student login is (the same as your PowerSchool login/password):

The two-digit year in which you are scheduled to graduate; for example 23 + The first five letters of your last name + The first three letters of your first name + Your middle initial (if you have one)

Your password is the first initial of your first name, first initial of last name followed by your six-digit ID #

Example:

The two-digit year in which you are scheduled to graduate

The first five letters of your last name

The first three letters of your first name

Your middle initial, if you have one

- Name: John J. Johnson (10th)
 - →Graduation Year 2023

Username: 23johnsjohj

Password: jj######

password = 1st initial of first name & 1st initial of last name + ID number


